PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Renovation combining two historic storefront spaces converted into single family residence. A serene, white interior contrasts the gray weathered exterior. Two front doors were retained streetside that open to the same entry of the living room and dining area. Walls were removed to ncreate singular expansive spaces filled with light and life. A large roof mounted skylight permits the natural light to flood the central stairwell.
